This player contract is to help players in the Euro United F.C. organization better understand their expectations

As a player for Euro United F.C., I pledge to:

- · Obey the rules of the MYSA, Euro United F.C. and the Massachusetts Premier League (MAPLE).
- · Work hard to improve my skills.
- · Be a team player get along within the team environment. Never place blame on my teammates.
- · Understand that you win and lose as a TEAM and always do it with CLASS. Always show good sportsmanship.
- · Be on time for training and arrive no later than 30 minutes before a game, ready to warm-up dressed in proper gear
- · Notify my coach and/or team manager when I will not be able to attend a scheduled practice or game.
- · Learn the Laws of the Game and obey them. Always give your best effort.
- · Respect and refrain from criticizing my coaches, teammates, parents, opponents and game officials.
- · Give my coaches my full attention and not speak when they are speaking. I will never talk back to my coaches.
- · Never argue with an official's decision. I will let my coach handle any issues.
- · Understand that fighting will not be tolerated and may result in suspension from club.
- · Conduct myself in a respectful manner and refrain from the use of abusive, obscene or profane language or gestures.
- · Treat everyone fairly, regardless of gender, color, sexual orientation, religion, political belief or economic status.
- · Abstain from using any substances that can harm by body. Pay attention to good nutrition and hydration and good night's rest.
- · Appreciate your parents' support
- · Behave like a professional be proud of your appearance. Always shake hands firmly and thank your opponent and referees
- · Playing Time: Playing time on all teams will be at the discretion of the coaches.
- Use of The MacDuffie School Fields: Euro United F.C. utilizes facilities owned by The MacDuffie School. In order for Euro United F.C. to maintain a good relationship with The McDuffie School, all Euro United F.C. members must always respect the facilities that are used for practices and games this includes keeping the grounds clean during and after use, abiding by all parking regulations and respecting all neighbors. Treat your opponent's facilities in the same manner as your own.
- · Uniform: Shin guards are mandatory. Players may not wear any type of jew elry during games or practices. During games, shirts will be tucked in and socks must cover shin guards. Any protective cast worn must be approved by the game official.
